In addition to her love for the Hamlet, Virginia Brown also loved interacting with people and never tired of learning. Thus, the BHF/BVA believes that giving a scholarship in her name to a young Brookhaven resident eager to learn and contribute to society is the most fitting way to perpetuate the memory of Ginger Brown.

All graduating, college-bound, high school seniors who reside in Brookhaven Hamlet are welcome to apply for the Virginia Brown Scholarship.
